

Note: Since Whonnock Lake Centre is in a municipal park that is open to the general public we have no control over any other events going on elsewhere in the park.

Rental area includes the inside of the hall, the eastern part (three quarters) of the patio (directly in front of the main hall), and the gazebo/grass area. All guests should keep away from the west end of the patio, the parking area to the west of the building or the ramp leading to the floating dock. These are monitored areas outside our jurisdiction.

Liquor licenses only cover alcohol consumption inside the hall and on the eastern part of the patio. The bar must be closed and music stopped by 12:30 AM

Smoking: is restricted to the covered area in front of the building and to one table on the patio.

Grass and Gazebo: No chairs or tents are allowed in the grass/gazebo area

Garbage: All garbage must be put into garbage cans. Cleaning up garbage (including cigarette butts) outside of the rented area or in the gardens will be charged to the Renter.

Parking: RV's are not permitted on the parking lot.

Camping: The Municipality does not allow anyone to camp or stay overnight within the limits of the park and that includes our parking lot.

Cleaning: It is the Renter's obligation to see that after their use the rented area is redelivered, cleaned up as per contract, latest at 2:00 AM on the night of the event.

Lighting: For security reasons LED candles are preferred. Traditional wax candles are only permitted if they are placed on the tables in large, low, and stable candlesticks where the base of the candle is stuck firmly in the candlestick or other secure holders--no chandeliers. For decorations use LED candles only. No flood lights other than LED lights--no exceptions.

Curtains and Draping: From the high wood lights only. There are only a few hooks for curtains at the windows and entrance way and no others to be added. Frames to be rented instead.

Hooks and Hangers: No nails, hooks, tacks, staples, or duct tape to be used for attachments on any wall or any window or doorframe inside or outside the building. Exception: hooks in the high wood light area to hang things from.

Damage: Dragging chairs, tables etc. or anything else across the floors or along the walls may cause damage to the surfaces. When resurfacing is required the Renter will be charged for the expense as for any other damage caused by their party.
